RESOLUTION NO. SP- 1797, S-2002

**A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE LAND TRANSPORTATION OFFICE (LTO) OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND COMMUNICATION (DOTC) TO CANCEL THE REGISTRATION OF ANY MOTOR VEHICLE PARTICIPATING IN ILLEGAL STREET RACING AND/OR SPEED TESTING ACTIVITIES, AS WELL AS TO CANCEL THE DRIVER'S LICENSES OF THE PARTICIPANTS, ORGANIZERS AND PARTICIPATING SPECTATORS OF ILLEGAL STREET RACING AND/OR SPEED TESTING ACTIVITIES IN QUEZON CITY.**


WHEREAS, there are reported upsurge in illegal street racing and/or speed testing activities not only in Quezon City, but in the other cities and municipalities in the country which have become a matter of serious concern among government leaders, law enforcers, parents and law abiding taxpayers in the country;

WHEREAS, there is a need for concerted action against illegal street racing and/or speed testing activities among national and local government agencies and units, their law enforcement arms, socio-civic groups, non-government organizations and people's organizations to ensure the safety and security of city streets and major thoroughfares, as well as to protect and promote the welfare, well-being and peace of mind of parents and law abiding taxpayers;

WHEREAS, the imposition of additional punitive measures, including administrative penalties, has become necessary to discourage or stop the conduct of illegal street racing and/or speed testing activities in Quezon City;









WHEREAS, the Land Transportation Office (LTO) of the Department of Transportation and Communication (DOTC) is mandated by law to help promote the security and safety of the city streets and major thoroughfares by ensuring that only law-abiding and responsible motorists, drivers and their vehicles are allowed to operate and use public and private roads, streets and thoroughfares in the country;

WHEREAS, illegal street racing and/or speed testing activities are considered criminal acts that are violative of national laws and local ordinances; thus, participants, organizers and participating spectators of illegal street racing and/or speed testing activities, do not deserve the privilege of being issued driver's licenses, nor use of public and private roads, streets and thoroughfares.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the Land Transportation Office (LTO) of the Department of Transportation and Communication (DOTC) to cancel the registration of any motor vehicle participating in illegal street racing and/or speed testing activities, as well as to cancel the driver's licenses of participants, organizers and participating spectators of illegal street racing and/or speed testing activities in Quezon City.
