WHEREAS, savings from the above expenses can be put in a better alternative use by the families;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City government purchases from time to time curtain quantities of these medicines for administration and/or use by hospitals, health centers and clinics in Quezon City.

Belmonte, Jr., to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Department of Trade and Industry for the direct procurement of inexpectable generic medicines to supply the "Botica sa Barangay" project and all mendicines requirements of the Quezon City government.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that henceforth, all medicinal requirments of the Quezon City Health Department, health centers and city-owned hespitals shall be procured directly from the Department of Trade and Industry.

RESOLVED, FURTHERMORE, that a copy of this resolution shall be furnished to Secretary Mar Roxas of the Department of Trade and Industry.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that the office of the City Mayor, the City Health Department and the Barangay Operations Center shall formulate the guideline is the implementation of this resolution.
