A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE WARMEST CONDOLENCES OF THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., THE VICE MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA AND THE QUEZON CITY COUNCIL TO THE FAMILY OF THE LATE DOÑA CONSUELO ECLAVEA LIM VDA. DE MORATO, WIDOW OF THE HONORABLE TOMAS B. MORATO, FIRST MAYOR AND FIRST CHIEF OF POLICE OF QUEZON CITY, WHO DIED IN SERENITY AT THE AGE OF NINETY-TWO (92).

WHEREAS, Doña Consuelo, a dedicated housewife and a doting mother to her six children, not to mention being a former teacher, was, likewise, very active with the Women's group, participating in various civic activities for the promotion of women's welfare and development;

WHEREAS, this simple lady won the title "Miss Quezon Province", her beauty and wit made her popular among illustrious personages when she facilitated the activities and social functions of her husband, living up to the expectations of the people as the first lady of the city;


WHEREAS, it is most significant that the city government recognize her achievements and contributions for a better and progressive city.

NOW, THEREFORE,


