RESOLUTION NO. SP-**1816**S-2002

A RESOLUTION GRANTING SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO GENATO MANAGEMENT CORPORATION TO OPERATE A MORTUARY IN THE BUILDING THAT USED TO HOUSE THE FORMER QUEZON CITY MANOR HOTEL.

Introduced by Councilors VICTOR V. FERRER, JR., ANTONIO E. INTON, JR., JESUS MANUEL "Bong" C. SUNTAY, RESTITUTO B. MALAÑGEN, VINCENT P. CRISOLOGO, ELIZABETH A. DELARMENTE, BERNADETTE HERRERA-DY, ROMMEL R. ABESAMIS, RAMON P. MEDALLA, ERIC Z. MEDINA, JORGE L. BANAL, JULIAN M.L. COSETENG and WENCEROM BENEDICT C. LAGUMBAY.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Manor Hotel was gutted by fire on August 18, 2001 resulting to the death of seventy-four (74) persons and leaving hundreds of others injured;

WHEREAS, the disastrous and tragic incident rendered the building desolate and of no commercial use;

WHEREAS, the owner of the Quezon City Manor Hotel has proposed to salvage the structure by converting the hotel into a mortuary;

WHEREAS, the owner of the structure has signified his intention to abide by the prescribed requirements imposed by the National Building Code, the building safety requirements of the Quezon City government, and secure the necessary business, health, environmental clearance certificate (ECC), mayor's and other permits as may be required by the City for the operation of the proposed mortuary;

WHEREAS, the owner of the proposed mortuary has offered two chapels in the building for the use of the indigent residents of Quezon City free of charge.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to grant, as it does hereby grant, a special use permit to Genato Management Corporation to operate a mortuary in the building that used to house the Quezon City Manor Hotel.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that two chapels in the proposed mortuary shall be reserved for the use of the indigent residents of Quezon City free of charge.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that upon complying with all the requirements and the necessary permits secured, the Quezon City Council hereby grants a special permit for the operation of the mortuary; Provided, however, that the approval of this resolution is without prejudice to the claims of all the fire victims of the Quezon City Manor tragedy now pending before the court of law and the judicial outcome of the case at bar.
