RESOLUTION NO. SP-1817 S-2002

A RESOLUTION URGING THE APPROPRIATE AUTHORITIES TO ENSURE THE EXPEDITIOUS, OBJECTIVE AND TRANSPARENT INVESTIGATION ON THE UNTIMELY AND PAINFUL DEATH OF THE WELL ADMIRER TV/MOVIE ICON MS. NIDA BLANCA AND TO ASSURE THAT SUCH ACT OF VIOLENCE IS DEALT WITH UNDER THE LAW AND RESOLVED WITHIN THE SHORTEST TIME POSSIBLE.

Introduced by Councilors **AIKO MELENDEZ-YLLANA, BERNADETTE HERRERA-DY and DIORELLA MARIA SOTTO-DE LEON.**

WHEREAS, Ms. Nida Blanca, a long time resident of White Plains, Quezon City, died a violent death in November 2001;

WHEREAS, her death has caused grief to the Filipino people and alarm to our peace and order situation;

WHEREAS, three months had already passed, but the investigating authorities have yet to present their findings and reports and the criminals have not been brought before the law;

WHEREAS, the public is particularly concerned about the outcome of the case as it involves their safety and security;


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY, IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the appropriate authorities to ensure the expeditious, objective and transparent investigation on the untimely and painful death of the well admired TV/Movie icon Ms. Nida Blanca and to assure that such act of violence is dealt with under the law and resolved within the shortest time possible.
