RESOLUTION NO. SP-1820, S-2002

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., CITY MAYOR, TO ALLOCATE THE AMOUNT OF FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS (P50,000.00) FROM THE CITY BUDGET UNDER ITEM GRANTS, AIDS AND CONTRIBUTIONS, AS THE CITY'S SUPPORT TO MS. ARIANNE BO CAOILI, WOMAN INTERNATIONAL CHESS MASTER, IN HER CAMPAIGN TO BECOME THE WORLD'S YOUNGEST GRAND MASTER

WHEREAS, MS. ARIANNE BO CAOILI, a Filipina who was born on December 22, 1986 in Pasay City of Filipino father, Mr. Arnold B. Caoili, and Australian mother, Ms. Annette Marjorie Caoili, is the "Philippines' Youngest Chess National Master" and "Youngest FIDE Master" at her present age of 14, an extraordinary feat that brought honor and acclaim to this country;

WHEREAS, Ms. Caoili, given a much needed support by her people and country, stands to become the world's youngest Grand Master, an achievement which would be unprecedented in the history of world chess and which would belie the notion of Filipino woman and further boast the Filipino's image as a people of superior intelligence;

WHEREAS, campaigning for the Grand Master Title, even to an extent which Ms. Caoili is not yet one, would require travels to various international competitions and with full time professional coaching which would need substantial funding;


