RESOLUTION NO. SP-1828S-2002

A RESOLUTION CONDUCTING THE ANNUAL SEARCH FOR THE MOST OUTSTANDING BARANGAY SECURITY AND DEVELOPMENT OFFICER OF QUEZON CITY IN RECOGNITION OF THEIR VALUABLE CONTRIBUTION IN THE MAINTENANCE OF PEACE AND ORDER AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, AND REQUESTING THE CITY MAYOR TO ANNUALLY CONSTITUTE SEARCH AND AWARD COMMITTEE FOR THE PURPOSE.

WHEREAS, the least recognized public servants in the Barangay are the Barangay Security and Development Officers, popularly known as the Barangay Tanods despite of its delicate, tiresome and complex duties and functions;

WHEREAS, barangay tanods had always been left out in terms of support, incentives and benefits knowing for a fact that they are completely in charge in the maintenance of peace and order in the barangay, and most of the time tap by the city government including national, as crowd controller, traffic aides and enforcer and even during conflagration or calamities serve as ancillary group of the disaster coordinating council or of the social services department;

WHEREAS, the recognition and full attention given by the city government to barangay tanods will serve as a concrete manifestation of support, thereby creating a sense of importance in their heart, boost their moral and feel inspired in the performance of their duties and functions;

WHEREAS, such recognition should include not only regular but also voluntary BSDO's because, they are performing the same duties and functions;

WHEREAS, such award could be given during first week of May which we have recently approved as Barangay Security Development Officers or BSDO Week.



NOW, THEREFORE,




