WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council has previously passed a resolution authorizing the Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr. City Mayor, this city to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with Japan Junior Chamber Inc. and Capitol Jaycees for the construction of a Day Care Center "Kanto JC Pangarap House" at Bankersville Subdivision, Barangay Payatas, District II, this city;

WHEREAS, the Japan Junior Chamber, Inc. donated a total amount worth Two Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php 200,000.00) to effect the construction;

WHEREAS, the city government welcomes this rare opportunity, as it is duty bound to render some assistance to both the parent and their children in terms of physical, social, intellectual and emotional development of pre-school children in the city;

WHEREAS, with this project, working parents will no longer find it difficult to take care of their children, aged 0-5, during the day when they are at work, as the center would provide supplemental care to the child.

**RESOLVED FURTHERMORE,** the non-buildable portion of the open space shall not be impaired by the Day Care Center to be constructed.


**RESOLVED FINALLY,** this Resolution shall take effect upon its approval.


