RESOLUTION NO. SP-**1849**, S-2002

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE 142 BARANGAYS IN QUEZON CITY TO JOIN AND SUPPORT THE DRIVE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (DLG) AND THE NATIONAL POLICE COMMISSION (NAPOLCOM) IN STRENGTHENING THE PEACE AND ORDER COMMITTEE IN THE BARANGAY.

WHEREAS, just recently a carjacking incident happened in San Francisco Del Monte, Quezon City, where a 20-year old student was asked to alight from his 2001 Honda Civic car and when he refused was forcibly and bodily pulled-out from his car parked right in-front of his house and witnessed by the other members of the household;

WHEREAS, the responsibility of maintaining peace and order in an area lies not only in the police but also to all sectors of society, particularly the barangay and other members of the community;

WHEREAS, the project launched by the Department of the Interior and Local Government and the National Police Commission needs the strong support not only by the barangay officials but also by the representatives of the community as they are the beneficiaries of the said program;

WHEREAS, the attainment of peace and order in the community requires the active participation of the inhabitants coming from the Punong Barangay, SK Chairman, members of the Lupon, members of the PNP, senior citizens, inter faith group, barangay tanod and three members of the non-governmental organizations, specifically in finding different approaches and solutions to the problem of peace and order.






