A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO BY AND AMONG THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, REPRESENTED BY THE HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., CITY MAYOR, THIS CITY, AS THE FIRST PARTY, THE HONORABLE REPRESENTATIVE LIZA LARGOZA-MAZA, AS THE SECOND PARTY AND KAIROS-PHILIPPINES/CHRISTIANS ON THE MOVE FOR SPIRITUAL AND SOCIAL SALVATION, AS THE THIRD PARTY, RELATIVE TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE DISASTER MANAGEMENT AND SUPPORT FOR URBAN POOR COMMUNITIES IN BARANGAY TATALON, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, various sectoral organizations represented by Kairos Philippines/Christians on the Move for Spiritual and Social Salvation sought the assistance and support of the Hon. Representative Liza Largoza-Maza, for the implementation of the Disaster Management and Support for Urban Poor Communities in Barangay Tatalon, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, its objective is to provide disaster preparedness training for indigent families, raise awareness on disaster prevention and community self-help consciousness and to help the local government efforts of empowering depressed communities towards improving their socio-economic condition;

WHEREAS, for that purpose, the amount of Three Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php 300,000.00) has been allocated by the office of Rep. Maza to be charged against the Priority Development Assistance Fund for Second Semester FY 2001 of Bayan Muna Party List;

WHEREAS, to implement the program, it has authorized the local government of Quezon City to implement the project in accordance with the proposal submitted pursuant to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations;

WHEREAS, the immediate ratification of the Memorandum of Agreement would be very beneficial to the less-fortunate constituents of our beloved City.


NOW, THEREFORE


RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Memorandum of Agreement entered into by the parties shall form an integral part of this resolution.
