RESOLUTION NO. SP-1869, S-2002

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE QUEZON CITY SCHOOL BOARD, THRU ITS CHAIRMAN, THE HONORABLE FELICANO R. BELMONTE, JR., CITY MAYOR, TO ALLOCATE THE AMOUNT OF SIX HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P600,000.00) FOR THE INITIAL REQUIREMENT IN THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ELECTRONIC LIBRARY AT THE QUIRINO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, the Quirino Elementary School in Project 2, which has a population of over four thousand students, has earned the exemplary distinction of being one of only two schools to be accredited by the National Institute for Science and Mathematics Education Development of the University of the Philippines as "High Performing Public Elementary School," an honor it received in fitting ceremonies on May 8, 2002, with City and Education officials in attendance;

WHEREAS, with the aforecited classification and capability of the school, determined after an exhaustive and thorough evaluation process, it becomes the City's best hope of producing leaders in various fields of public service, science and the arts, provided the school is equipped with adequate modern facilities which would hone and build its students competitiveness;

WHEREAS, a modern electronic library would be a big boost to any school's teaching capabilities.



NOW, THEREFORE,


