RESOLUTION NO. SP-**1874**S-2002

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE NEGOTIATED CONTRACT ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, REPRESENTED BY THE HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., CITY MAYOR, THIS CITY, AND THE MARIGOLD DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION, REPRESENTED BY ITS PRESIDENT AND GENERAL MANAGER, MR. APOLLO Y. CHUA, FOR THE REPAIR AND/OR RENOVATION OF THE AMORANTO SPORTS COMPLEX.

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code mandated all local government units to exercise other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provisions of the basic services and facilities including city buildings, cultural centers, public parks, playgrounds, and sports facilities and other equipments (Sec. 17 (2) (vii));

WHEREAS, City Mayors are vested with the power to represent the City in all its business transactions and sign on its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations; and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law (Sec. 455 (1) (vi), RA 7160);

WHEREAS, the Pre-qualification, Bids and Awards Committee (PBAC) has resolved to undertake the repair and/or renovation of the Amoranto Sports Complex by a negotiated contract after a determination that the same is a fire hazard posing actual and imminent danger to life, limb and property;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the resolution made by the PBAC relative to the renovation and/or repair of Amoranto Sports Complex, the Quezon City government represented by the Honorable City Mayor Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., hereinafter referred to as the First Party, entered into a Negotiated Contract with Marigold Development Corporation, a domestic corporation existing under and by virtue of Philippine Laws with business address at 20 Kapiligan St., Brgy. Imelda,

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Quezon City, represented by its President and General Manager, Apollo Y. Chua, hereinafter referred to as the Second Party on April 5, 2002;

WHEREAS, this Negotiated Contract is subject to ratification by the City Council.


NOW, THEREFORE,

Chua, for the repair and/or renovation of the Amoranto Sports Complex.


RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the said Negotiated Contract shall form an integral part of this resolution.
