

WHEREAS, Mayor Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., started his career in government service in the 1960's when he served as Presidential Staff Assistant of then President Diosdado Macapagal, Special Assistant to the Secretary of Finance, Special Assistant to the Commission of Customs, and Executive Assistant of the Central bank of the Philippines;

WHEREAS, upon assumption to office in 1986, former President Corazon C. Aquino appointed him to lead various government-owned corporations that were on the brink of bankruptcy, to wit; President and General Manager of the Government Service and Insurance System and the Manila Hotel, Chairman of the National Reinsurance Corporation of the Philippines, member of the Board of Directors of the San Miguel Corporation and the Philippine Long Distance and Telecommunications, Co., and most significantly, the President and Chief Executive Officer of the Philippine Airlines;

WHEREAS, he has proven himself as a public servant of unquestionable integrity and moral values, having served the needs of the people with an unblemished reputation and standing by his principles and ideals, as 3-time elected Congressman of the 4th District of Quezon City (virtually unopposed on his 2nd and 3rd run), having served both as House Minority Floor Leader and House Speaker of the 11th Congress, a feat only Mayor Belmonte, Jr., has done;



NOW, THEREFORE,



RESOLVED, FURTHER, that this resolution of congratulations be awarded in scroll form.






