RESOLUTION NO. SP-**1880**3-2002

A RESOLUTION GRANTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE BEREAVED FAMILY OF THE LATE PO3 JOSELITO C. VELASQUEZ, MEMBER OF THE CENTRAL POLICE DISTRICT OFFICE (CPDO), PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE (PNP), IN THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY THOUSAND PESOS (P30,000.00) TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE APPROPRIATION FOR GRANTS, SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS IN THE 2002 ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE CITY TREASURY.

WHEREAS, PO3 Joselito C. Velasquez was a member of the Central Police District Office (CPDO), assigned at the Criminal Investigation Division, Camp Tomas Karingal, Quezon City, and in active duty for ten (10) years;

WHEREAS, on July 19, 1998, while performing his official duties, he suffered severe chest pain which was later found to be Cardio-Respiratory Arrest that caused his death the following day, July 20, 1998;

WHEREAS, the untimely demise of PO3 Velasquez placed his family in emotional as well as financial difficulties having no other member of the family to sustain their daily living and other expenses;

WHEREAS, almost all the life savings of PO3 Velasquez were spent for his medical and funeral services, and without him as the sole breadwinner, his family now faces a bleak future;


WHEREAS, in recognition to the invaluable contribution of PO3 Velasquez in the preservation of peace and order and public safety, it is appropriate for the City Government to grant financial assistance to his family in the amount of P30,000.00, conformably with Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-154, S-94.


NOW, THEREFORE,


