A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE HONORABLE MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO ALLOCATE THE AMOUNT OF FORTY-ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED FORTY-ONE PESOS AND THIRTY-FIVE CENTAVOS (P41,541.35) FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A COVERED WALK ALONG TOLENTINO STREET AND LINCOLN STREET OF BARANGAY SAN ANTONIO, QUEZON CITY.




NOW, THEREFORE


