RESOLUTION NO. SP-**1889**, S-2002

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE QUEZON CITY GENERAL HOSPITAL DIRECTOR TO REGULATE THE USE OF THE BACKGATE OF THE HOSPITAL TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF HOSPITAL PATIENTS FROM ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS, TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS, NOISE POLLUTION, DUST AND INFECTIONS AND PREVENT DELAYS IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS OF THE HOSPITALS.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City General Hospital (QCGH), a 250-bed capacity tertiary general hospital owned and operated by the Quezon City Government, is located along Seminary Road in Barangay Babay Toro;

WHEREAS, the Seminary Road extends only from EDSA to the former San Jose Seminary which is now the Quezon City General Hospital;

WHEREAS, a hospital and its environment should always be clean and free from pollution such as smoke, exhaust gases like carbon monoxide, dust, and should be noise-free and quiet;

WHEREAS, the QCGH is presently undergoing expansion improvements like installation of sewage and drainage system, construction of the passing areas and park development, construction of the Out-Patient Department (OPD), administrative building, and the Burn Center;

WHEREAS, the closure of the Seminary Road inside the QCGH will prevent the delays in the completion of these projects, prevent the pollution of the hospital environment and further enhance the recovery of the sick patients in the hospital;

WHEREAS, there are alternative access routes to EDSA, such as the access road inside the Pugad Lawin Villas Subdivision at the back of the hospital and the Congressional Avenue.


NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the Director of the Quezon City General Hospital to regulate the use of the backgate of the hospital to vehicular traffic to ensure the safety of hospital patients from environmental hazards, traffic accidents, noise pollution, dust and infections and prevent delays in the construction of the infrastructure projects of the hospitals.


RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Director of the Quezon City General Hospital will formulate the guidelines for the regulation of the backgate.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that the City Council be furnished with the above-mentioned guidelines.


