WHEREAS, in line with the recent declaration of President Gloria Macapagal Arroyo that the "fight against graft is one of the policy bedrocks" of her administration, His Honor, City Mayor Feliciano Belmonte, Jr., for his part has vowed to eradicate corruption in the Quezon City Government;

WHEREAS, to signal the start of a serious anti-corruption campaign at City Hall, City Mayor Belmonte recently created and organized the Task Force: Quezon City Information Technology (TF-QCIT) the functions of which will ultimately result in the transparency of public administration in the Quezon City Government;

WHEREAS, under its given functions, the TF-QCIT will ultimately evolve a system which will allow public and private citizens to monitor the corrupt-prone applications via the INTERNET, similar to the benefits of OPEN or the Online Procedures Enhancement for Civil Applications, the internationally accepted anti-corruption initiative of the City of Seoul, Korea;

WHEREAS, this interim project can begin with the installation of a suggestion/comments drop box in every Department/Office at the City Hall where reports of irregularities can be dropped by officials, employees, private citizens should sign the report and with necessary signed witnesses and submit documents in support of this reports;
