RESOLUTION NO. SP-**1917**-2002

A RESOLUTION URGING THE HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., CITY MAYOR, THIS CITY, TO ALLOCATE THE AMOUNT OF THREE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS (P350,000.00) FOR THE INSTALLATION OF STREETLIGHTING FACILITIES ALONG BAYANI STREET, BARANGAY DOÑA IMELDA IN DISTRICT IV, QUEZON CITY, TO BE TAKEN FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE CITY TREASURY.

WHEREAS, Book III, Title Three, Chapter III, Article III, Section 458 (a) of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that:

"The sangguniang panlungsod, as the legislative body of the city, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the city and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code and in the proper exercise of the corporate powers of the city as provided for under Section 22 of this code, and shall:"

xxx

(5) (v) "Regulate the use of streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalks, bridges, parks and other public places and approve the construction, improvement, repair and maintenance of the same; establish bus and vehicle stops and terminals or regulate the use of the same by privately-owned vehicles which serve the public; regulate garages and the operation of conveyances for hire; designates stands to be occupied by public vehicles when not in use; regulate the putting up of signs, signposts, awnings and awning posts on the streets; and provide for the lighting, cleaning and sprinkling of streets and public places;"


WHEREAS, maintaining a well-functioning streetlights and/or street lamps is vital for the night time safety of the motorists and pedestrians in Quezon City;


NOW, THEREFORE,
