RESOLUTION NO. SP-**1919**S-2002

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE QUEZON CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO ENTER INTO A NEGOTIATED CONTRACT WITH REPUTABLE SUPPLIERS FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS TO BE USED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION/IMPROVEMENT OF WAITING SHEDS AND STREET LIGHTS IN THE DIFFERENT BARANGAYS LOCATED IN THE SECOND DISTRICT OF QUEZON CITY IN THE ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION SIX HUNDRED FIFTY-SIX THOUSAND PESOS (P1,656,000.00) TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE LUMP SUM APPROPRIATION FUND UNDER THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR.

WHEREAS, the construction and improvement of waiting sheds and street lights in the different barangays located in the Second District of Quezon City is among the priority development projects of the Quezon City government;

WHEREAS, time is the essence in the implementation of said project in the face of uncertainties and vagaries of weather conditions, and other factors affecting the early completion of said project, including but not limited to the rapidly increasing cost of labor and construction materials;

WHEREAS, there is a sense of urgency, and a felt need to immediately finish said project in order to provide for the comfort and convenience of the residents of said barangays who have long suffered from the existing unattended conditions of waiting sheds and streetlights;


WHEREAS, in order to avoid unnecessary delay which normally attends public bidding, there is a felt need to authorize the City Mayor of Quezon City, Hon. Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to enter into a negotiated contract with reputable suppliers for the supply and delivery of construction materials to be used for the improvement and construction of waiting sheds and streetlights in the different barangays of Second District of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b) (1) (vi) of RA 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations and such other documents upon authority of Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, Quezon City Mayor, Hon. Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to enter into a negotiated contract with reputable suppliers for the supply and delivery of construction materials to be used for the construction and improvement of waiting sheds and streetlights in the different barangays located in the Second District of Quezon City, in the estimated amount of One Million Six Hundred Fifty-Six Thousand Pesos (P1,656,000.00) to be charged against the lump sum appropriation fund under the Office of the City Mayor.
