RESOLUTION NO. SP-1935 S, 2002

A RESOLUTION URGING THE CITY COUNCIL TO GRANT ADDITIONAL FRANCHISE TO THE TWO HUNDRED (200) PETITIONERS FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTORIZED TRICYCLE FOR HIRE PLYING WITHIN THE ROUTE AND TERRITORY OF BARANGAY BATASAN HILLS COVERED BY BATASAN HILLS TRICYCLE OPERATORS AND DRIVERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 01, Series of 2001 by the BATASAN HILLS TRICYCLE OPERATORS AND DRIVERS ASSOCIATION, INC. whereby it was adopted:

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of the Board of Directors duly seconded by the members of the Board of Directors present, Resolved to request from the authorities concerned TWO HUNDRED (200) additional Route Measurement Capacity (RMC) for Batasan Hills Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association (BATODA) to augment the increasing tricycle commuters in that franchise route. (copy attached as Annex "A")

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 036, Series of 2001 of the Barangay Council of Batasan Hills likewise adopted and resolved;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of the Barangay Council duly seconded by the members of the council present, Resolved, as it is hereby resolved, to request two hundred (200) additional RMC to QCTFB for BATODA. " (Copy attached as Annex "B")

WHEREAS, the operation of colorum tricycle plying within Barangay Commonwealth will be legalized;

WHEREAS, the grant of Franchise to the petitioners and the consequential legalization will dramatically diminish the incidents of graft and corruption in this sector of society, particularly in Barangay Batasan Hills;

WHEREAS, the need for a more responsive transport service as opposed to the even growing population of the Barangay and the outlying areas will be achieved.

NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the City Council to grant additional franchise to the two hundred (200) petitioners for the operation of motorized tricycles for hire to ply within its route and territory of Barangay Batasan Hills Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association



RESOLVED, FURTHERMORE, that the Tricycle Franchising Board will be the one to scrutinize all the documents and be the one to choose who will be the beneficiaries and also to protect those people that has been a colorum since 1993.


RESOLVED, FINALLY, that copies of this Resolution be furnished the concerned Barangay and other offices concerned for information and ready reference.
