BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby strongly urge, all owners of funeral parlors operating within the territorial jurisdiction of Quezon City to accredit with the Philippine Mortuary Association for mutual benefit and general interest of the poor constituents of Quezon City.
