RESOLUTION NO. SP-1943, S-2002

A RESOLUTION URGING THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE PHILIPPINE COUNCILORS LEAGUE (PCL) TO NAME THE MAJOR HALL OF THE PCL BUILDING LOCATED AT COASTAL ROAD PLAZA, LAS PIÑAS, IN HONOR OF THE LATE QUEZON CITY COUNCILOR, HONORABLE GUILLERMO "MANONG WILLY" C. ALTUNA, PCL FIRST NATIONAL CHAIRMAN.

WHEREAS, among his notable achievements, the late Councilor Guillermo C. Altuna, or "Manong Willy", as he was fondly called by his colleagues and constituents spearheaded the organization of the 18,000-strong Philippine Councilors League during his first term as Quezon City Councilor in 1988 and was unanimously elected the first PCL National Chairman, a position which he concurrently held undefeated during his three (3) consecutive terms until his untimely death on October 8, 1996.;

WHEREAS, through the energetic and able leadership of the late Councilor Guillermo "Manong Willy" C. Altuna as PCL National Chairman, he initiated and made possible, with the assistance of the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), the organization of regional and provincial chapters of the Philippine Councilors League nationwide;

WHEREAS, the late PCL Chairman Guillermo "Manong Willy" C. Altuna was mainly responsible in lobbying for the construction of the Philippine Councilors League Building in 1992 during the incumbency of former President

Ding.

Fidel V. Ramos and Speaker Jose De Venecia an impressive building designed for the lodging of councilors throughout the Philippines who have official business in Metro Manila and for other important functions/purposes;



NOW, THEREFORE,


