

WHEREAS, Section 458 (xv) of RA 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code authorizes the City Council to establish and provide for the maintenance and improvement of jails and detention centers, institute a sound jail management program and appropriate funds for the subsistence of detainees and convicted prisoners in the city;

WHEREAS, skin ailments and other communicable diseases are reported to have infected inmates at the Quezon City jail due to overcrowding and insufficiency of basic necessities;

WHEREAS, as part of its mandate to provide for the maintenance of the city jail, the City Council recognize the expertise of the City Health Department in dealing with the above-mentioned problems and the fact that effective measures will be undertaken by said department in close coordination with the Bureau of Jail Management and Penology.


NOW, THEREFORE,


RESOLVED, FURTHER, that reports on the results of the case study and proposed solutions shall be submitted to the City Council.
