A RESOLUTION COMMENDING MR. MASAHIKO FUJII FOR HIS EXEMPLARY CONTRIBUTION AND GENEROUS DONATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE HALFWAY HOUSE AND TRAINING CENTER FOR THE PAYATAS CHILDREN AND BESTOWING UPON HIM THE TITLE "HONORARY CITIZEN" OF QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, the Rotary Club of Quezon City North, D-3780 sponsored WCS Project ID No. 3500 of Rotary International which undertook the construction of the Halfway House and Training Center for the Children of Payatas;


