A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., CITY MAYOR, THIS CITY, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH PHILIPPINE HEALTH INSURANCE CORPORATION REPRESENTED BY FRANCISCO T. DUQUE III, M.D., PRESIDENT AND CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER, AND GLAXOSMITHKLINE PHILIPPINES, INC., REPRESENTED BY MR. AMADO T. TADENA, PRESIDENT AND MANAGING DIRECTOR, RELATIVE TO THE HEALTH PROGRAM FOR THE CONSTITUENTS OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation together with Glaxosmithkline Philippines, Inc. proposed a Memorandum of Agreement for the implementation of Health Program for the marginalized or indigent sector of the City;

WHEREAS, the said agreement shall endeavor to make essential health services available to qualified constituents at affordable cost in response to the Filipino need for access to quality health care;

WHEREAS, the City Legal Department through its 4th Indorsement dated May 7, 2002 recommended for the approval of MOA by and between Philhealth and Quezon City Government containing the same purpose, except that with the present MOA, Glaxosmithkline is added, which will assume part of the premium contribution of the Quezon City Government;

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WHEREAS, the City Legal Department recommended for the approval of the Memorandum of Agreement after finding that the provisions of the said agreement to be in order;

WHEREAS, the Honorable City Mayor requests, through a letter addressed to the honorable City Council, for the authority to enter into the aforementioned Agreement;


WHEREAS, the City Council shares the same vision of providing an efficient care financing and delivery program to the less privileged sector of our society.

Belmonte, Jr., City Mayor, this City, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with Philippine Health Insurance Corporation, represented by Francisco T. Duque, M.D., President and Chief Executive Officer and Glaxosmithkline Philippines, Inc., represented by Mr. Amado T. Tadena, President and Managing Director, relative to the Health Program for the constituents of the City;

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that all pertinent documents relative to the Memorandum of Agreement shall form an integral part of this resolution.
