Resolution No. SP- 1967, S-2002

A RESOLUTION GRANTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE VICTIMS OF THE FIRE THAT OCCURRED IN 787 QUEZON AVENUE, BARANGAY STA. CRUZ, DISTRICT I, QUEZON CITY, LAST OCTOBER 6, 2002 THE AMOUNT TO BE TAKEN FROM THE CALAMITY OR EMERGENCY FUND OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT.

WHEREAS, at noon of October 6, 2002 a fire occurred and blazed the structures at 787 Quezon Avenue, Barangay Sta. Cruz, District I, Quezon City, leaving about 106 families homeless;

WHEREAS, the City Government can express its sympathy and concern by way of providing financial assistance to the victims of the fire.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to grant, as it does hereby grant, financial assistance to the victims of the fire that occurred at 787 Quezon Avenue, Barangay Sta. Cruz, District I, Quezon City, last October 6, 2002, the amount to be taken from the calamity or emergency fund of the City Government or from any available funds of the City, as follows:

House Owners -	P2,000.00
House renters/shares-	1,000.00.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Social Services Development Department (SSDD) shall validate/authenticate the list of the fire victims categorized into house owners or house renters/sharers and submit the same to the Office of the City Mayor making representation for the early release of the financial assistance to the qualified recipients.
