RESOLUTION NO. SP-1979, 'S-2002

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO ENTER INTO A NEGOTIATED CONTRACT/S WITH REPUTABLE AND QUEZON CITY ACCREDITED CONSTRUCTION CORPORATION/S FOR THE REHABILITATION/CONSTRUCTION OF DAY CARE CENTERS AND PATHWALKS IN DISTRICT II, THIS CITY, AT SUCH AMOUNT NOT EXCEEDING ONE MILLION SIX HUNDRED FIFTY SIX THOUSAND PESOS (P1,656,000.00) TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE 2003 LUMP SUM APPROPRIATION OF THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR.

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

Introduced by Councilor RAMON P. MEDALLA.

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WHEREAS, the proposed rehabilitation/construction of Day Care Centers and Pathwalks, have been targeted to be undertaken among other projects by the City government to promote and enhance the health, safety and convenience of the city constituents;

WHEREAS, time is of the essence due to the urgency of the above proposed projects and the rising cost of labor and materials, and in order to avoid unnecessary delay attendant to the normal conduct of public bidding, it is deemed expedient that the City government enters into negotiated contract/s for the early completion of the above stated projects;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", the City Mayor "shall represent the city in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance".




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NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to enter into a negotiated contract/s with reputable and Quezon City accredited construction corporation/s for the rehabilitation/construction of Day Care Centers and Pathwalks in District II, this city, at such amount not exceeding One Million Six Hundred Fifty-Six Thousand Pesos (P1, 656,000.00) to be charged against the 2003 Lump Sum Appropriation of the Office of the City Mayor, subject to existing auditing and accounting rules and regulations.


