RESOLUTION NO. SP- 1992, S-2003

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., CITY MAYOR, TO NEGOTIATE WITH THE POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES (PUP) TO PURCHASE THE PROPERTY FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF "PAMANTASAN NG LUNGSOD NG QUEZON" OR "COMMUNITY COLLEGE."

WHEREAS, Article XIV, Section 2(1) of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the state shall establish, maintain and support a complete, adequate and integrated system of education relevant to the needs of the people and society;

WHEREAS, Article XIV, Section 1 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the state shall protect and promote the rights of all citizens to quality education at all levels and shall take appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all;

WHEREAS, the continuing increase of unemployment and mass poverty are the persisting concerns faced by the Quezon City Government and the country as a whole;

WHEREAS, to respond to these problems, there must be a more competent and skillful populace responsive to the present needs of the industries; therefore, the creation of educational institutions and programs that emphasizes not only short-term non-formal skills trainings, but also formal baccalaureate courses of higher learning will help alleviate poverty and unemployment and will hasten the attainment of social progress, growth and development of Quezon City;




NOW, THEREFORE,


