RESOLUTION NO. SP-**1996**S-2003

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE FULL SUPPORT OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 246, PROPOSING TO ESTABLISH THE PRE-NEED PLAN CODE OF THE PHILIPPINES AND URGING THE EARLY APPROVAL THEREOF.

Introduced by Councilors BERNADETTE HERRERA-DY, DANTE M. DE GUZMAN, AIKO MELENDEZ-YLLANA and FRANZ S. PUMAREN.

WHEREAS, there are presently more than fifty six (56) corporations engaged in the sale of pre-need plans;

WHEREAS, over three and a half (3 1/2) million plans have been sold and their assets have amounted to ninety-seven billion pesos (P97B);

WHEREAS, Quezon City residents are definitely among the buyers of these pre-need plans;

WHEREAS, the proliferation of these pre-need corporations have required their strict and close regulation for the protection of innocent parties from unscrupulous practices;


WHEREAS, HB 246 proposes to strengthen the government's regulatory capabilities to ensure that the industry serves its purpose and does not become a forum for abuse.


RESOLVED, FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished to the House of Representatives, the Senate, and the Office of the President of the Philippines.


