RESOLUTION NO. SP-2003 3-2003

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING ALL BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS WITHIN QUEZON CITY TO SUBMIT THEIR LISTS OF JOB VACANCIES TO THE INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS OFFICE (IRO).


