A RESOLUTION URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (DepED) AND THE COMMISSION ON HIGHER EDUCATION (CHED) TO REGULATE AND DISCOURAGE THE PRACTICE OF "NO PAYMENT NO EXAM" POLICY OF SOME PRIVATE SCHOOLS.

WHEREAS, such practice of some private schools in denying them to take the examination should not be allowed to continue and must be sanctioned by the proper authorities;
