RESOLUTION NO. SP **2010** S'-2003

A RESOLUTION URGING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR TO ISSUE AN EXECUTIVE ORDER ENABLING THE CITY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CITIES ALLIANCE AND ASIAN DEVELOPMENT BANK'S TWIN PROGRAMS KNOWN AS THE CITY DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY (CDS) AND CITY WITHOUT SLUMS (CWS) THROUGH THE CREATION OF A STEERING COMMITTEE AND A COUNTERPART TEAM THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, the CITIES ALLIANCE is the global partnership of cities and their development partners that aims to assist cities in meeting the challenges of the 21st century through the promotion of pro-poor policies, good governance and prosperous cities without slums through comprehensive targeted interventions;

WHEREAS, the ASIAN DEVELOPMENT BANK, as one of the CITIES ALLIANCE's development partners, is launching the City Development Strategy (CDS) and the CITIES WITHOUT SLUMS (CWS) in three (3) pilot areas in Metro Manila, one of which is Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the CDS is an action plan for equitable growth, developed and sustained through public participation to improve the quality of life for the city residents;

WHEREAS, the CDS will also serve as the city's corporate plan reflecting a collective city vision and strategy, development strategies to promote growth and address poverty alleviation, action plans for each strategy (including plans and programs), and policies that lead to an improved investment climate;

WHEREAS, the CWS program indicates interventions needed to effectively implement the poverty reduction strategy prescribed and incorporated in the CDS;

WHEREAS, the thrust of the CWS includes slum eradication through upgrading which covers: physical improvements (land tenure and sanitation) environmental, social, economic and organizational improvements designed and implemented with the participation of the stake holders;

WHEREAS, to enable the City to fully participate in both programs, the City government should create a Steering Committee and the CDS Counterpart Team required to undertake the CDS process;


WHEREAS, the City's Steering Committee and CDS Counterpart Team may be created through an Executive Order issued by the office of the Honorable City Mayor.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the Honorable City Mayor to issue the necessary Executive Order, enabling the city to participate in the Cities Alliance and Asian Development Bank's Twin Programs known as the City Development Strategy (CDS) and City Without Slums (CWS) through the creation of the City's Steering Committee and a Counterpart Team to enable Quezon City to fully participate in the CDS and CWS programs.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the office of the City Mayor shall furnish the City Council a copy of the Executive Order.
