RESOLUTION NO. SP 2015, s-2003

A RESOLUTION URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND COMMUNICATIONS, THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, AND THE CENTRAL POLICE DISTRICT OFFICE TO STRICTLY IMPLEMENT THE FARE DISCOUNT LAW FOR STUDENTS WHICH WAS PREVIOUSLY IMPLEMENTED BY THE DEFUNCT BUREAU OF LAND TRANSPORTATION (BLT).

NOW, THEREFORE,


