A RESOLUTION URGING THE LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD AND THE DIVISION OF CITY SCHOOLS TO FACILITATE THE PROGRAM AND EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATION OF PUTTING-UP AN E-LIBRARY IN ALL PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS OF QUEZON CITY.

- (1) Construction, repair and maintenance of school buildings and other facilities of public elementary and secondary schools".

WHEREAS, most of the libraries of our public schools lack the necessary reference materials such as encyclopedia, dictionary, atlas and other instructional materials;

WHEREAS, the reason is, these books are very expensive and we have quite a number of public high schools;

WHEREAS, converting their libraries to e-libraries would render their libraries complete with reference materials at a lower cost;


WHEREAS, there is a necessity to have an access to these materials that would allow our high school graduates to compete with the other young people of this country and the rest of the world;

NOW, THEREFORE,




