RESOLUTION NO. SP 2062, S-2003

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., CITY MAYOR, TO FORM A QUEZON CITY TASK FORCE ON SEVERE ACUTE RESPIRATORY SYNDROME (SARS), AND TO UTILIZE THE CITY'S CALAMITY FUND FOR THE PURPOSE.

WHEREAS, the Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome (SARS) has now become a grave and real threat to all Filipinos with the confirmation of the disease in at least three cases in the country, with 2 confirmed fatalities;

WHEREAS, in order to contain the threat and reduce to the barest minimum the possibility of the disease rearing its ugly head in the city, and in view of the need to ensure the city's preparedness and capability to handle any possible case, there is an urgent need to formally set up a body that will take charge of responding to the threat.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., City Mayor, to set up a Quezon City Task Force on SARS to take charge of the monitoring of SARS cases, as well as the preparation and implementation of all necessary measures to protect the city residents from the deadly disease.


