RESOLUTION NO. SP-**2065**, S-2003

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC ORDER AND SAFETY (DPOS) TO STRICTLY IMPLEMENT ORDINANCE NO. SP-867, S-2000, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "THE ALTERNATING ONE LANE PARKING SYSTEM ORDINANCE OF QUEZON CITY."

WHEREAS, the City Council of Quezon City has already approved Ordinance No. SP-867, S-2000, otherwise known as "The Alternating One Lane Parking System of Quezon City,"

WHEREAS, the said Ordinance mandated the Department of Public Order and Safety (DPOS) to fully implement the same together with its consequent penalties in any violation therefor, to wit;

SECTION 3. Alternating One-Lane Parking System- Upon approval hereof x x x

Provided, further, that upon expiration of the fifteen (15) day period within which to implement the provisions of this ordinance, the Department of Public Order and Safety (DPOS) is hereby given plenary power and authority to carry out the provision of this ordinance."

SECTION 8. Penalties. - Violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall be meted by a fine not exceeding Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) and an imprisonment of not less than six months nor more than one (1) year. The amount of fine collected under this Section shall accrue to the Safety, Peace and Order Fund of the barangay concerned, where such apprehension was effected.

Stalled and/or illegally parked vehicles, in violation of this ordinance, shall likewise be towed, impounded and a fine imposed on the driver of registered owner as provided for under Ordinance No. SP-455, S-1996.


Upon verified complaint elective Barangay officials found, verified and determined not to have enforced the provisions of this ordinance shall be preventively suspended and held administratively liable x x x"

WHEREAS, there is an urgent need to effect full implementation of the said ordinance, thus, compelling the author to propose the same.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby strongly urge, the Department of Public Order and Safety (DPOS), to strictly implement Ordinance No. SP-867, S-2000, otherwise known as the "ALTERNATING ONE LANE PARKING SYSTEM ORDINANCE OF QUEZON CITY."
