RESOLUTION NO. SP **2066**, S-2003

A RESOLUTION GRANTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE VICTIMS OF THE FIRE THAT OCCURRED IN P. DELA CRUZ STREET, BARANGAY SAN BARTOLOME, DISTRICT II, QUEZON CITY LAST DECEMBER 14, 2002 THE AMOUNT TO BE TAKEN FROM THE CALAMITY OR EMERGENCY FUND OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT.

WHEREAS, in the evening of December 14, 2002, a fire occurred and blazed the structures at P. Dela Cruz Street, Barangay San Bartolome, District II, Quezon City, leaving about twenty nine (29) families homeless;

WHEREAS, the City government can express its sympathy and concern by way of providing financial assistance to the victims of the fire.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to grant, as it does hereby grant, financial assistance to the victims of the fire that occurred at P. Dela Cruz Street, Barangay San Bartolome, District II, Quezon City, last December 14, 2002, the amount to be taken from the calamity or emergency fund of the City government or from any available fund of the City as follows:


House Owners ----- P 2,000.00
House Renters/Sharers ----- 1,000.00

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Social Services Development Department (SSDD) shall validate/authenticate the list of the fire victims categorized into house owners or house renters/sharers and to submit the same to the Office of the City Mayor making representation for the early release of the financial assistance to the qualified recipients;

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that the Office of the Mayor shall revalidate and confirm the list submitted by the Social Service Development Department (SSDD) which will be the basis for the preparation of the immediate release of funds allocated for the purpose.
