RESOLUTION NO. SP **2070**S-2003

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND GRANTING TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES MULTI-PURPOSE COOPERATIVE, INC., AS OFFICIAL TIME THEY HAVE INCURRED EFFECTIVE ON THE INITIATION OF THEIR SHELTER PROGRAM IN THEIR PURSUIT TO PROVIDE HOUSING PROJECT FOR THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT RANK-AND-FILE EMPLOYEES IN CONSONANCE WITH THE CALL TO PROMOTE THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF PEOPLE'S ORGANIZATIONS (PO'S), NON GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS (NGO'S) AND THE PRIVATE SECTOR TO MAKE THEM ACTIVE PARTNERS IN THE PURSUIT OF LOCAL AUTONOMY AS ENSHRINED IN THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991 (R.A. NO. 7160).




NOW, THEREFORE,


