A RESOLUTION URGING THE QUEZON CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO DIRECT THE CITY ENGINEER TO PREPARE THE PLAN AND PROGRAM OF WORK, AND ESTIMATE OF COST FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A LARGE COVERED CONVENTION HALL FOR QUEZON CITY, TO BE LOCATED WITHIN THE QUEZON CITY HALL COMPLEX OR ANY OTHER SUITABLE SITE IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, Quezon City is a premier city located in the heart of Metropolitan Manila, with 142 big barangays and a population of about 2,158,142;

WHEREAS, it is indeed unfortunate that notwithstanding its huge size, where it is the biggest local government in Metro Manila in terms of land area, its large population, and importance as Premier City, Quezon City has no covered convention hall large enough to serve as a proper venue for many of its public activities requiring the presence or attendance of large number of people;

WHEREAS, it is rather embarrassing that many times Quezon City had to celebrate the anniversary of its foundation in a place outside its territorial jurisdiction because there is no adequate public covered venue which could accommodate the large number of people expected to be in attendance for said purpose;

WHEREAS, there is a felt need for the construction of a large covered convention hall for Quezon City.


NOW, THEREFORE,
