RESOLUTION NO. SP-2081, S-2003

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE ACCEPTANCE MADE BY THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., ON BEHALF OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF THE DONATION OF THE FORTY-EIGHT (48) ROAD AND ALLEY LOTS, AND TWO (2) OPEN SPACES AND PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS, LOCATED WITHIN NORTH OLYMPUS SUBDIVISION, PHASES II AND III, ZABARTE ROAD, QUEZON CITY, DONATED BY STATE LAND INVESTMENT CORPORATION, REPRESENTED BY ITS VICE-PRESIDENTS REGINO P. KHO AND BIENVENIDO S. UY, AND E.M. RAMOS DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION REPRESENTED BY ITS PRESIDENT EMERITO B. RAMOS, JR.

WHEREAS, State Land Investment Corporation, a corporation duly registered under Philippine laws with principal address at 3rd floor, State Center Building, 333 Juan Luna St., Binondo, Manila, represented by its Senior Vice Presidents, REGINO P. KHO and BIENVENIDO S. UY, and E.M. RAMOS DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION, a corporation duly registered under Philippine laws with principal address at 273 Katipunan Avenue, Loyola Heights, Quezon City, represented by its President EMERITO B. RAMOS, JR., herein referred to as the DONORS. The aforementioned corporations are the owners/developers of Phases II and III

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of the subdivision project known as North Olympus Subdivision located at Zabarte Road, Novaliches, Quezon City, who donated forty-eight (48) road and alley lots, and two (2) open spaces and parks and playgrounds of the said subdivision project to the Government of Quezon City represented by its Honorable Mayor Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., herein referred as the DONEE;

WHEREAS, Section 455 (1) (vi) R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, empowers the City Mayor to represent the City in all its business transactions and sign on its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations; and such other documents upon authority of the sangguniang panlungsod or pursuant to law;

WHEREAS, said DONEE, as represented by the Honorable City Mayor, accepted the donation of the above-mentioned properties for which it expressed its appreciation and gratitude to the DONORS;

WHEREAS, the acceptance of the donations made by the City Mayor requires ratification by the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to ratify, as it does hereby ratify, the Acceptance made by the Honorable City Mayor Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., on behalf of the City government of the donation of the forty-eight (48) road and alley lots, and two (2) open spaces and parks and playgrounds, located within North Olympus Subdivision, Phases II and III, Zabarte Road, Novaliches, Quezon City, donated by State Land Corporation and E.M. Ramos Development Corporation to the Quezon City government.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Acceptance made by the City Mayor shall form an integral part of this resolution.

RESOLVED, FURTHERMORE, that this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
