RESOLUTION NO. SP-**2085** S-2003

A RESOLUTION URGING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO CONSIDER AND DIRECT THE QUEZON CITY ANTI-SQUATTING TASK FORCE TO COORDINATE WITH THE NATIONAL POLICE TASK FORCE ON PROFESSIONAL SQUATTERS AND SQUATTING SYNDICATES IN DETERRING SQUATTING PROBLEMS IN QUEZON CITY AND APPREHENDING PROFESSIONAL SQUATTERS AND SQUATTING SYNDICATES.

WHEREAS, professional squatters are individuals or groups who occupy lands without the express consent of the landowners and who have sufficient income for legitimate housing;

WHEREAS, squatting syndicates are groups of persons engaged in the illegal business of squatter housing for profit or gain;

WHEREAS, since 1990, Quezon City has been identified by the Census and Population Housing as the number one among cities and municipalities with the biggest number of squatters and a home for professional squatters and squatting syndicates;


WHEREAS, the National Police Task Force on professional squatters and syndicates has identified professional squatters and squatting syndicates responsible for the squatting operations and other modus operandi within the City;

WHEREAS, the operation of these professional squatters and syndicates in the City has caused several land owners to loss their lands and the City government a hard time in deterring the problem of squatting.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the Honorable City Mayor Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to consider and direct the Quezon City Anti-Squatting Task Force to coordinate with the National Police Task Force on Professional Squatters and Squatting Syndicates in deterring squatting problems in Quezon City and apprehending professional squatters and squatting syndicates.
