RESOLUTION NO. SP-2088, S-2003

A RESOLUTION URGING THE LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD TO STUDY THE POSSIBILITY OF CREATING AND ESTABLISHING MANRESA PRIMARY OR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND RECOMMEND TO THE CONGRESS OF THE PHILIPPINES TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE.

WHEREAS, there is an urgent need to create and establish a primary or elementary school in Manresa, District I, Quezon City, due to the increasing number of pupils residing in Barangay Manresa who are studying in different neighboring barangay elementary schools;

WHEREAS, there is a strong clamor by the residents to establish a primary or elementary school in the area to ensure the safety of the pupils;


WHEREAS, it is the main thrust of the national and local government to give priority to education as embodied and enshrined in Article II, Section 17 of the 1987 Constitution, to wit:

“The state shall give priority to education, science and technology, arts, culture and sports to foster patriotism and nationalism, accelerate social progress, and promote total human liberation and development”

WHEREAS, it is Congress, under existing laws, which has the authority to appropriate funds for the establishment of schools while the Local School Board determines the budgetary needs for its operation and maintenance in accordance with the criteria set forth by the Department of Education;




