RESOLUTION NO. SP- 2120, S-2003

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD TO INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL SCHOOL BOARD BUDGET AN APPROPRIATION SUFFICIENT TO MEET THE COST OF BUILDING/ESTABLISHING AND MAINTAINING ADDITIONAL SCHOOL BUILDINGS IN MINES ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, Section 99 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides;

"Functions of Local School Boards. - The provincial, city or municipal school board shall:

- (a) Determine, in accordance with the criteria set by the Department of Education, Culture and Sports, the annual supplementary budgetary needs for the operation and maintenance of public schools within the province, city or municipality, as the case may be, the supplementary local cost of meeting such needs, which shall be reflected in the form of an annual school board x x x;"




