A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE SINCEREST CONGRATULATIONS OF QUEZON CITY, HEADED BY MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE JR., VICE MAYOR HERBERT M. 

WHEREAS, by the use of tact and statesmanship, the President, thru her chosen men, was able to diffuse the volatile situation and ended the crisis in the evening of the same day;


WHEREAS, the action of the President is indeed admirable and is worthy of the praise by the international community.
