RESOLUTION NO. SP- **2134**, S-2003

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., CITY MAYOR, QUEZON CITY, TO FIX THE RATE AT TWO THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED FIFTY PESOS (P2,150.00) PER TRIP FOR THE SPECIAL OPERATIONS OF THE SPECIAL ACTION TEAM (SAT).

WHEREAS, the Honorable City Mayor Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., issued Executive Order No. 17, Series of 2002, that created a Special Action Team (SAT) mandated to implement a comprehensive, integrated and sustainable special operations program of the City pertaining to sanitation, illegal vending, illegal structures and other obstruction destructive to the aesthetic beauty of the City;

WHEREAS, for the attainment of the designed program of the Special Action Team there is an immediate need to provide it with logistical requirements such as trucks and other equipment necessary for its effective and efficient special operations;

WHEREAS, a special provision in the contract for solid waste collection, cleaning and disposal services was incorporated which provides for the right of the contractor to the reimbursement of expenses incurred in support of the special operations in providing manpower, equipment, and trucks to the City government;

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WHEREAS, the said special provision did not specify the actual rate to be reimbursed in the event the contractor provides the City with additional trips of the trucks and other equipments necessary to carry out the operations;


WHEREAS, the amount of Two Thousand One Hundred Fifty Pesos (P2,150.00) per trip of the truck and other equipment is a reasonable rate to sustain the operations of the contractor and advantageous as well to the City government;

WHEREAS, the granting of authority to the City Mayor to fix the rate was deemed urgent to carry out the special operations.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., City Mayor, Quezon City, to fix the rate at Two Thousand One Hundred Fifty Pesos (P2,150.00) per trip for the special operations of the Special Action Team (SAT).
