RESOLUTION NO. SP **2145**, S-2003

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE LAND TRANSPORTATION FRANCHISING AND REGULATORY BOARD (LTFRB) OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND COMMUNICATIONS TO AMEND AND/OR MODIFY THE ORIGINAL CUBAO-LAGRO VIA KALAYAAN ROUTE OF THE LAGRO-CUBAO OPERATORS AND DRIVERS ASSOCIATION (LACODA).

WHEREAS, in the interest of the riding/commuting public and in order to alleviate the grave and worsening traffic condition of our City thoroughfares covered and included within the approved route of the Lagro-Cubao Operators and Drivers Association (LACODA) brought about in part by the establishment of the MRT-2, as well as various new infrastructures that were built and constructed within the Araneta Commercial area, a series of route amendments and modifications have been proposed both to the City government and to the management of the Araneta Center;

WHEREAS, on behalf of the LACODA, the Department of Public Order and Safety (DPOS) of the Quezon City government has requested Mr. Ernesto San Juan, Administrative Manager of Araneta Center to allow the members of the LACODA to extend their route up to and/or inside the Araneta Commercial Center which request was eventually granted;

WHEREAS, the proposed modification of the original route of the LACODA, from its present route which is from Lagro Terminal, Quirino Highway, Regalado Ave., (SM Fairview), Fairview Avenue, Commonwealth Avenue, Elliptical Road, Kalayaan Avenue, Kamias Road, K-9, Ermin Garcia, Harvard, shall be from Harvard-Aurora Boulevard to 15th Avenue, P. Tuazon, Gen. Romulo, Yale and back via E. Garcia - K-14 (to original same route).

WHEREAS, Section 458 (5)(v) of the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that the sangguniang panlungsod, as the legislative of the City, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions which shall ensure the efficient and effective delivery of the basic services and facilities as provided for under Section 17 of this Code, and in addition to said services and facilities shall:

“Regulate the use of streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalks, bridges, parks and other public places and approve the construction, improvement, repair and maintenance of the same; establish bus and vehicle stops and terminals or regulate the use of the same by privately-owned vehicles which serve the public; regulate garages and the operation of conveyances for hire, designate stands to be occupied by public vehicles when not in use; regulate the putting up of signs, signposts; awnings and awnings of posts on the streets; and provide for lighting, cleaning and sprinkling of streets and public places”;

WHEREAS, the present route requested to be modified is not in contravention or violative of, but within the public utility vehicles approved routes of the LTFRB.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to request, as it does hereby request, the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) of the Department of Transportation and Communications to amend and/or modify the original Cubao-Lagro via Kalayaan route of the Lagro-Cubao Operators and Drivers Association (LACODA), as follows: Lagro Terminal, Quirino Highway, Regalado Avenue, (SM Fairview), Fairview Avenue, Commonwealth Avenue,
