RESOLUTION NO. SP-**2153**, S-2003

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. SP-1897, S-2002, ENTITLED, "A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING HIS HONOR, CITY MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO ENTER INTO A NEGOTIATED CONTRACT WITH ALL WOMEN CONTRACTORS AND SUPPLIERS FOR THE REPAINTING OF DAY CARE CENTERS, PEDESTRIAN LANES, TRAFFIC SIGNS, BASKETBALL BOARDS, WASTE MANAGEMENT RECEPTACLES AND BARANGAY OUTPOSTS, AT SUCH AMOUNT NOT EXCEEDING ITS COST ESTIMATE TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE LUMP SUM APPROPRIATION OF THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR."

Introduced by Councilors BERNADETTE HERRERA-DY, VICTOR V. FERRER, JR., ANTONIO E. INTON, JR., DANTE M. DE GUZMAN, WILMA AMORANTO-SARINO, ELIZABETH A. DELARMENTE, MARY ANN L. SUSANO and JESUS MANUEL C. SUNTAY.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. SP-1897, S-2002, was approved on Second Reading on November 19, 2002 and was confirmed by the City Council on December 3, 2002;

WHEREAS, in order to rectify the term which should be with any reputable contractor instead of All Women Contractors and Suppliers;

WHEREAS, the title and dispositive portion of the said measure should be "A Resolution authorizing his Honor, City Mayor Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to enter into a negotiated contract with any reputable contractor or supplier for the repainting of day care centers, pedestrian lanes, traffic signs, basketball boards, waste management receptacles and barangay outposts, at such amount not exceeding its cost estimate to be charged against the Lump Sum Appropriation Fund (Capital Outlay Infrastructure Fund) under the Office of the City Mayor";

WHEREAS, there is a need to amend the approved resolution to give authorization to the Honorable City Mayor for the immediate improvement of the above stated projects.

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NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to amend, as it does hereby amend, Resolution No. SP-1897, S-2002, entitled, "A resolution authorizing his Honor, City Mayor Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to enter into a negotiated contract with All Women Contractors and Suppliers for the repainting of day care centers, pedestrian lanes, traffic signs, basketball boards, waste management receptacles and barangay outposts, at such amount not exceeding its cost estimate to be charged against the Lump Sum Appropriation of the Office of the City Mayor."
