RESOLUTION NO. SP **2168**, S-2003

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., AS CHAIRMAN OF THE QUEZON CITY SCHOOL BOARD TO DEPLOY TWO (2) SECURITY GUARDS EACH TO ALL NINETY-SIX (96) PUBLIC ELEMENTARY AND FORTY-TWO (42) SECONDARY SCHOOLS IN QUEZON CITY TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF THE STUDENTS WHILE INSIDE AND NEAR THE PREMISES OF THE SCHOOL AND AVOID VANDALISM AND DESTRUCTION OF SCHOOL PROPERTY DURING NIGHT TIME.

WHEREAS, the safety of the students/pupils is the primordial concern and responsibility of the principals and school officials, even while inside or near the premises of the school;

WHEREAS, such duty to protect the pupils/students from harm cannot be given entirely to teachers and principals, considering the voluminous work they are attending while inside the school;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City School Board has the authority to appropriate certain amount from the Special Education Fund to hire and pay the services of security guards to relieve or at least lessen the work of teachers and principals in looking after the students' safety while inside the school;


WHEREAS, students in public elementary and secondary schools are easy prey of criminals and by those engage in drug trade and likewise school properties are always the subject of vandalism or destruction committed by bystanders and drug users, particularly those who are using school buildings as venue for pot session and illegal activities.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby strongly urge, the City Mayor, Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., as Chairman of the Quezon City School Board to deploy two (2) security guards each to all ninety-six (96) public elementary and forty-two (42) secondary schools in Quezon City to ensure the safety of the students while inside and near the premises of the school and avoid vandalism and destruction of school property during night time.
