A RESOLUTION URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO INTEGRATE GENDER ISSUES IN THE CURRICULUM OF OUR EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, it is imperative that we inculcate in our young the value of self-respect and care for others, as pre-requisite to happy living in a just and fair society.




