RESOLUTION NO. SP-**2180**, S-2003

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING HIS HONOR, CITY MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO ENTER INTO A NEGOTIATED CONTRACT WITH ANY REPUTABLE CONTRACTOR OR SUPPLIER FOR THE REPAIR AND CONSTRUCTION OF VARIOUS DEVELOPMENTAL PROJECTS IN THE DIFFERENT SCHOOLS, LIVELIHOOD CENTER IN BARANGAY DEL MONTE, LANDSCAPING IN BARANGAY VETERANS VILLAGE AND INFORMATIONAL BILLBOARDS LOCATED IN THE FIRST DISTRICT OF QUEZON CITY, IN AN AMOUNT NOT EXCEEDING TWO MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P2,500,000.00) TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE LUMP SUM APPROPRIATION FROM THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR.



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WHEREAS, Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that the City Mayor shall "represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations and such other documents upon authority of the sangguniang panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance";

WHEREAS, the various developmental projects in the different schools within District I include: repair of path walk, guard house, waiting area, sidewalk, ceiling, downspout repair, toilets, landscaping of sidewalk, construction of stage, tiles, steel casement window, drinking fountain, welcome arch, elevated water tank, lavatory counter, covered path walk, industrial classroom, covered bleachers, concrete basketball courts, three (3) storey building, livelihood center in Barangay Del Monte, landscaping in Barangay Veterans Village and informational billboards and others;

WHEREAS, since time is of the essence in the construction of the above proposed projects, in view of the rising cost of labor and materials, and to avoid unnecessary delay in conducting the normal process of public bidding, it is deemed expedient that the City government enters into a negotiated contract for the early completion of the above-stated projects.


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NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, his Honor, City Mayor Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to enter into a negotiated contract with any reputable contractor or supplier for the repair and construction of various developmental projects in the different schools, livelihood center in Barangay Del Monte, landscaping in Barangay Veterans Village and informational billboards located in the First District of Quezon City in an amount not exceeding Two Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (P2,500,000.00) to be charged against the Lump Sum Appropriation from the Office of the City Mayor.
